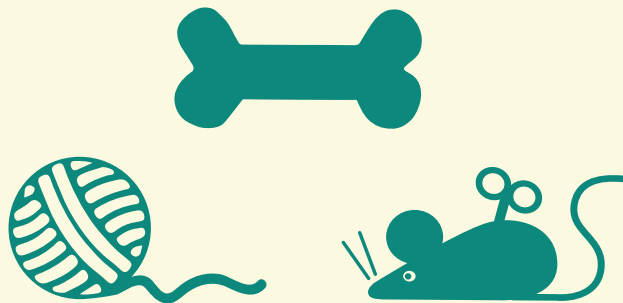
Pet diabetes affects approximately

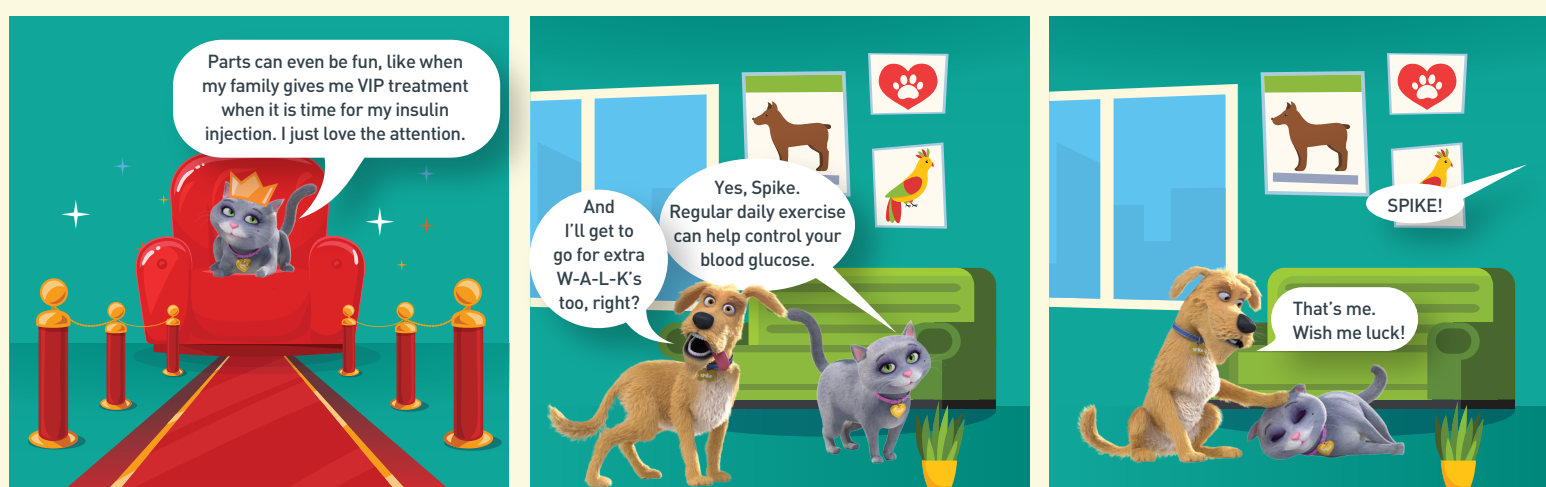
cats and dogs.^{1,2}
